Today we are going to investigate:

- How to find Canis Major in the sky
- · What kind of creature does Canis major represent
- Why Sirius is a special star
- A deep sky object in Canis Major

Activities

Today we are going to look at a winter sky constellation. Start up Night Sky and use the Space Travel tile to change the time and date to any evening in December and look for a small star pattern called Canis Major. This is one of the few constellations which actually looks like the creature it is named after!


The brightest star in the whole sky is located in Canis Major and is called Sirius. It is bright because it is a big star and it is close to us. Tap on the 10 to bring up the information tile for Sirius. Use this tile to find the answer to this question.


Question: What does the name Sirius mean in ancient Greek?



Although Sirius looks like one bright star it is actually two stars very close together. One is much brighter than the other. You need a giant telescope to see the smaller of the two stars.
